The year 1918 was an inflection point in the Twentieth Century. The Great War was ending, empires were collapsing, the Spanish Influenza epidemic was raging, and the world was in turmoil. Base Cards: The 330 base card set contains people, places, and events from 1918 with a focus on the End of the Great War. Cards #301-330 are super short-printed (SSP) and there are (40) cards in the set that have image variations. Parallel cards include Aurora #/25 and Alloy #/149. Printer plates (1/1) are included for each card (4 colors per card).

Uniform Fabric Cards: Louis Connelly served in the US Navy during the Great War, having enlisted during the Spanish- American War, rising through the ranks to retire as a Captain. These cards include fabric from one of Captain Connelly's uniforms. Pull rate is 1:152 packs.

Pinup Cards: Our models provide a stunning retrospective on women's fashion in 1918 through this series of pin-up- style cards in Alloy finish. Pull rate is 1:17 packs.

Autographed pinup cards signed by the model depicted. Cards were autographed in red and black ink. For each model 40 cards were signed in black ink and 10 were signed with red ink. Pull rate is 1:510 packs.
