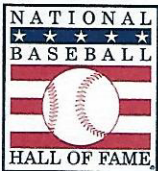
One of my biggest thrills in baseball was when the first time I ever faced Babe Ruth, I struck him out, I was <sup>just</sup> six weeks out of college.
